### ***Hellenic Society of Rheology (HSR)***

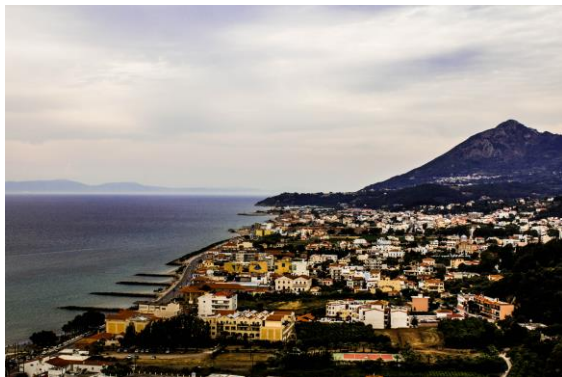

It is affiliated with the European Society of Rheology (ESR) and dedicated to the promotion of scientific activities and advancement in the fields of rheology and fluid mechanics.

### ***Scope of the Conference***

The Meeting is open to all scientists and engineers conducting research or interested in the field of rheology and in fluid mechanics. The program will consist of 4 invited keynote lectures, oral and poster contributions.

### ***Topics***

Special emphasis will be given to the following fields of research:

- wet systems: solutions, suspensions and granular matter
- melts, composites and fracture
- interfacial phenomena: films, emulsions, surfactants and microfluidics
- biologically relevant flows
- liquid-solid transitions: yielding, vitrification and gelation
- non-viscometric and turbulent flows
- computational rheology, non-Newtonian fluid mechanics

### ***Deadlines***

Prospective authors are invited to submit a short abstract preferably by e-mail (max. 250 words), along with a preliminary registration form, not later than **January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2019**. Notification of acceptance will be mailed by **February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019**.

### ***Location***

The Meeting will be held from Monday, June 24<sup>th</sup>, to Thursday, June 27<sup>th</sup> 2019, in Samos, Greece. The venue will be announced soon.

### ***Registration***

The registration fee will be 300 Euros (220 Euros for students, and 200 Euros for accompanying persons) before April 1st, 2019 and 330 Euros (250 Euros for students, and 220 Euros accompanying persons) afterwards. It will include transportation from/to the airport to/from the location of the conference, coffee breaks, the book of abstracts, the welcome reception, the banquet, an additional meal, and participation to an excursion.
